



You need to check your tyres regularly (when cold) finding the information in your owners manual, if you do not have reliable pressure gauge, then go to your local garage to check and adjust as nessecary.



A badly worn tyre, no tread left, you are risking 3 points on your licence and risking a fine of up to £2500, furthermore you are risking your own life and other road users around you!

The tyre tread wear indicators are visible, these are telling you that your tyres have worn to the legal limit of 1.6 mm.





No tread in the middle of the tyre, how is this going to affect your overall stopping distance? This has gone well past the legal minimum tread depth! If you have not spotted this on your tyre, you need your eyes checking!

Cracks/cuts in your tyre wall are just as dangerous as a bald tyre and should be changed as soon as possible. Your tyre could explode at high speed, which could cause an accident!



This is how a brand new tyre looks, they should be changed every 5 years or when worn!
